Scripture Reading:

Hebrews 1-4:13

Lesson Questions:

1. What verses about the supremacy of Jesus encourage, comfort, or challenge you, and why? (Hebrews 1)
2. Compare Jesus to angels. What do you learn? (Hebrews 1)
3. The letter's author quoted Old Testament verses to explain Jesus' person and work. How does this connection impact your confidence in Jesus and God's word? (Hebrews 1)
4. What is revealed about Jesus, and why was it necessary for the Son to become human in order to secure our salvation? (Hebrews 2)
5. What warning and consequence of ignoring the warning are given in 2:1-4?
6. What fears and temptations challenge your faith, and what truths about Jesus equip you for victory in these struggles? (Hebrews 2)
7. What are similarities and differences between Jesus and Moses? (Hebrews 3)
8. What are practical ways people fix their thoughts on Jesus? Why is it important to do so? (Hebrews 3)
9. What aspects of Christian community have you experienced, or want to pursue, that help guard believers against hardened hearts? (Hebrews 3)
10. Describe the kind of "rest" these verses present. Who is involved, and how does it look, feel, or sound? (Hebrews 4:1-13)
11. How do people enter God's rest, and why have you personally done so - or not? (Hebrews 4:1-13)
12. What phrases describing God's Word help you understand its work in our lives (4:12-13)?
13. What is the most important or challenging thing you learned this week? (Review)
14. How do these chapters impact your view of the Bible and the value of studying God's Word together? (Review)
15. What circumstances can you view differently by remembering Jesus Christ is superior to all creation? (Reflect)
16. How did the week's verses, study or discussion impact your relationship with God? (Reflect)
