

Hebrews Lesson 2

Scripture Reading:

Hebrews 4:14 - 7

Lesson Questions:

1. Identify the requirements for high priests given in this passage. How is Jesus Christ more qualified than any other person? (Hebrews 4:14-5:10)
2. Read how Jesus was tempted in Matthew 4:1-11 and 26:36-44. How do Jesus' temptations allow Him to empathize with you, and what other help do these passages provide? (Hebrews 4:14-5:10)
3. What did Jesus gain through suffering, and how do these truths apply to your difficult seasons of life? (Hebrews 4:14-5:10)
4. What "elementary teachings" are listed in 6:1-3, and how would you define them for someone? (Hebrews 5:11 - 6:3)
5. What are some ways believers grow in spiritual maturity? (Hebrews 5:11 - 6:3)
6. What is your greatest challenge to spiritual growth today? (Hebrews 5:11 - 6:3)
7. Some Christians differ in their understanding about Hebrews 6:4-6. What ways can this warning be understood, and what is it intended to accomplish?
8. In 6:9-12, where is encouragement for believers found, and what is your response to these?
9. What truths about God and His promises anchor you and enable you to stand firm as you follow Him? (Hebrews 6:4-20)
10. What are similarities and differences between Melchizedek and Christ? (Focus on 7:1-10.)
11. How is Christ presented as a superior priest in comparison to any other? (Also compare to Leviticus 10:11; 16:9; Numbers 1:53 or other Scriptures for help.) (Hebrews 7)
12. What about God's character stands out in this week's passage, and how do you see that attribute displayed in the world today? (Review)
13. How does this passage help you make sense of why Jesus' priesthood matter? (Review)
14. How might you benefit from focusing on Jesus as Great High Priest this week? (Reflect)
15. What from the week's verses, study or discussion speaks to any questions or doubts you have been faced with lately? (Reflect)
